## Budget Description

Relay for Life Color Run 5K (Date: September 30, 2017 Time: 9:00am-1:00pm Location: Old Well)

-Fundraiser in the form of a 5k color run. One of our largest events of the year and in this year's case our first organization-wide event of the year. Runners pay a fee of \$25 which covers their shirt, running number and cost of color packets.

-Runners run along a predetermined course beginning at the Old Well. They will run through 4 color check-points where colored chalk will be thrown on them. There will also be Relay volunteers lining the path handing out water and cheering participants on.

Cost Breakdown:

- Equipment: \$1500, includes speakers, sign-up tables, tents, etc.
- Professional Labor Fees: \$600, includes the amount paid to an outside company which has the equipment for race timing and numbering
- Security: \$300, due to the large number of participants and route of the event security is required to stand at certain points along the events path
- Printing and Publicity: \$150, includes fliers of the event and social media presences
- Office Supplies: \$100, includes all of the supplies necessary for a smooth sign-in process (pens, markers, posters, tape, etc.)

Relay for Life Breasticle Festival (Date: October 11, 2017 Time: 6:30pm-8:30pm Location: Pit)

- Carnival themed event that's purpose is to raise awareness of prevention, detection, and treatment of both testicular and breast cancers.

- The event will begin with speakers to introduce the goals of Relay for Life as a whole. After introductions many small events will be taking place, all of which will either generate funds or raise awareness of our organization and purpose.

-Some activities will require donations, while others will require joining Relay for Life, which costs a one-time fee of \$10.

Cost Breakdown:

- Equipment: \$1500 includes large circus style tents and their setup fees and speakers.
- Printing and Publicity: \$150, includes fliers of the event and social media presences
- Office Supplies: \$100, includes all of the supplies necessary for the execution of creating and hosting the event (pens, markers, posters, tape, etc.)

Relay for Life Kickoff Concert (Date: October 27, 2017 Time: TBD Location: TBD)

- This is an annual event where many of UNC's acapella and dance groups get to showcase their talent and support Relay for Life.

- The event begins with speakers discussing their cancer stories and stressing the importance of funding cancer research. After the performances Relay for Life's directors give a closing and place importance on what we fight for.

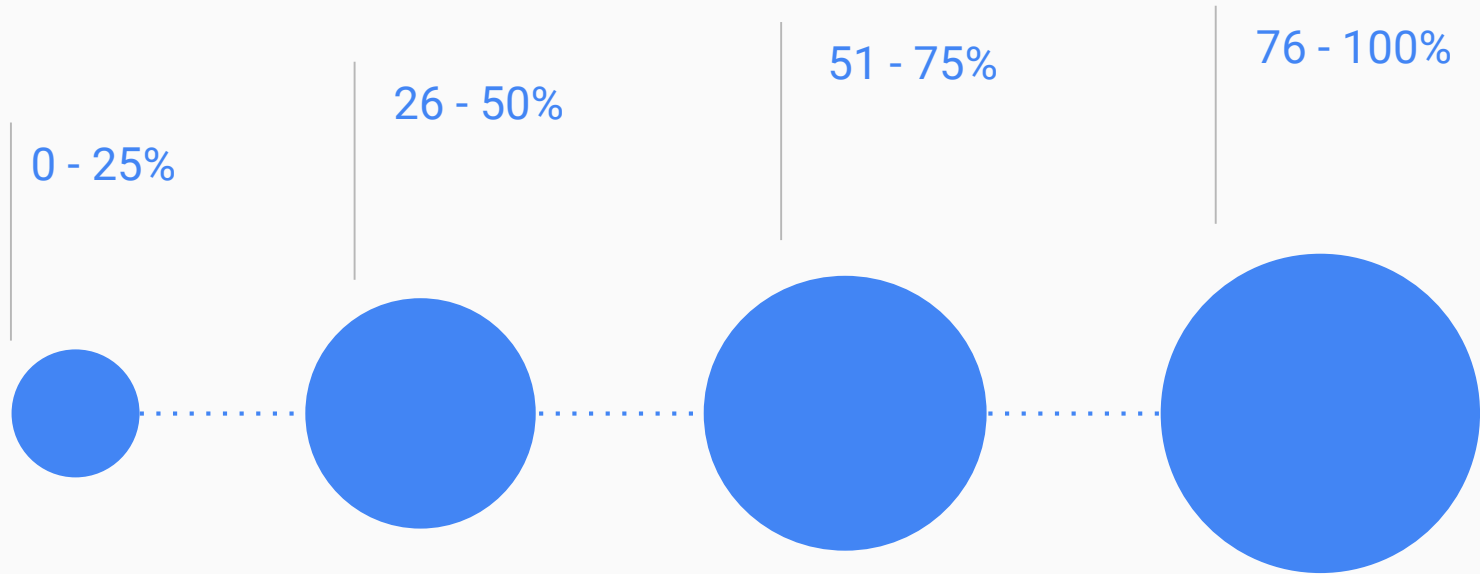
- Admission is usually \$5 depending on the number of acts which end up being showcased.

Cost Breakdown:

- Equipment: \$1000, includes speakers, tents, chairs, tables, etc necessary for hosting
- Printing and Publicity: \$150, includes fliers of the event and social media presences
- Office supplies: \$100, includes all of the supplies necessary for the execution of creating and hosting the event (pens, markers, posters, tape, etc.)

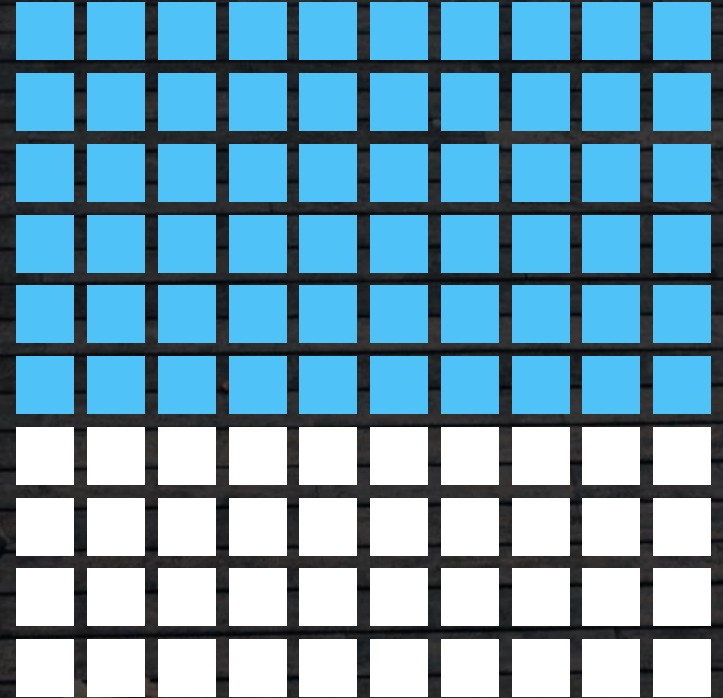

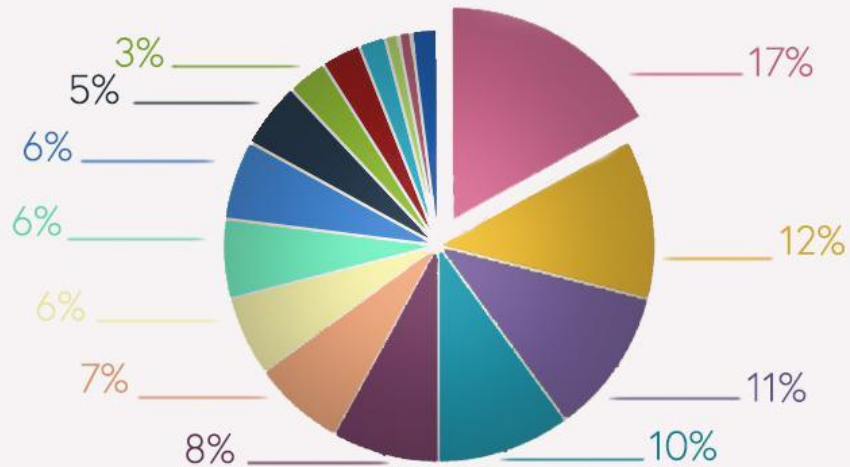
