WHEREAS, the Undergraduate Student Code stipulates that the baskets of funding requests are randomly assigned hearing dates;

WHEREAS, historically and by tradition, all three branches of Student Government have received funding hearings at the front of the queue;

WHEREAS, this tradition should be codified in order to remain consistent with the Undergraduate Student Code;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL THAT

Section 1.

Title IV, Chapter 4, Section 405(B) shall read as follows:

B. The order in which each basket of requests will be heard shall be determined using a random number generator. The Undergraduate Executive Branch, Undergraduate Senate, Student Supreme Court, and the Honor System shall have their funding requests heard by FC at the first appropriations meeting in both the Fall and Spring Subsequent Appropriations cycles.
