WHEREAS, the Undergraduate Student Code stipulates that the total amount of funds to be appropriated in each Subsequent Appropriations period shall be evenly divided among the funding meetings;

WHEREAS, the Undergraduate Student Code requires that certain Student Government entities receive a specified minimum amount of funding to finance expenditures defined the Code;

WHEREAS, the required funding has the unintended effect of reducing the discretionary appropriations meeting in the meeting(s) where that funding must be granted, which harms all other organizations whose funding hearings fall on that day;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL THAT

Section 1.

Title IV, Chapter 4, Section 405(3) shall read as follows:

3. The FCC shall divide the amount of funding available for the current Subsequent Appropriations cycle proportionally among the meetings. First, the FCC shall set aside whatever portion of the Subsequent Appropriations Budget is necessary to fund expenditures required by the Code. The remaining funds shall be the Discretionary Appropriations Budget. To determine the amount of funding available for a given meeting, the FCC shall divide the dollar amount of funding requested for that meeting by the total dollar amount of all Subsequent Appropriations requests. The FCC shall then multiply that number by the Discretionary Appropriations Budget, and the product shall be the amount of funding available for that meeting.
