WHEREAS, the Ethics laws shall be updated to reflect pertinent changes.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL THAT

Section 1. Amendments

Title II, Chapter 5, Section 510. Special Events. shall be amended as follows:

Section 510. Special Events

- A. Failure to attend the event, or provide written notice to the Ethics Chair at least twenty-four (24) 3 hours before the event, will result in one (1) unexcused absence.



Title II, Chapter 5, Section 511. Select Committees. shall be amended as follows:

Section 511. Select Committees

- A. The Chair of a Select Committee shall schedule and notify the committee members of the time and place of any meeting of the committee at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance.
- B. Any guests invited to attend a select committee meeting shall be notified of the meeting at least seventy-two (72) hours in advance.
- C. At the time of scheduling, the Chair may deem attendance mandatory for all of the senators in the committee.
- D. If a meeting is mandatory, the Ethics Chair will excuse an absence according to the attendance requirements outlined in Section 505.
