a. Messages from the Student Body President

- i. Senate meetings will be livestreamed. Next week, there will be a discussion about delegating authorities. There will be a general alumni board meeting on Friday. This will be a full meeting. There was a discussion about implementing wellness days in addition to Spring Break to allow for mental health breaks for students. The Richard Epps Emerging leaders election will be held within the upcoming days.

b. Messages from the USG Vice President

- i. Shares about having a Non-disclosure Agreement (NDA) for parking, believes that since students are the ones who are organizing the parking spots, they are viewing a lot of personal information submitted through the parking lottery application. He calls for an NDA to be in place, so student personal information is confidential and not shared.

c. Messages from the USG Treasurer

- i. A survey will be sent out to determine whether the time frame that UNC shuttle buses operate during window before Fall Break is a sufficient and correct time for students to be taken to airports. They are trying to correct bus time issues so students are able to get to classes on time. They want to extend the spending deadline. SVAC meeting will be held tomorrow on Thursday and Friday, September 30 and October 1. This meeting will discuss tuition and fees.

d. Messages from the USG Director of State and External Affairs

- i. They are figuring out other consequences for noise complaints that students are receiving off campus. They are in the works of drafting budget for senate panel. They explained that they are creating a promotional video for international students and trying to understand the needs for international students as well as other international organizations on campus.

e. Messages from the Undergraduate Student Attorney General

- i. They will hold weekly office hours to review student conduct and honor code issues. It has been chosen this way because of how these issues are not handled in a timely manner and they believe this is a step in processing and arranging faster solutions for any honor system violation.
